

UConn Early College Experience conducts end-of-term course evaluations for each course section offered intended to provide instructors with student feedback regarding the course. The survey questions were developed in coordination with NACEP.

Course Evaluation Questions

Range response (Strongly Agree, Agree, Neutral/No Opinion, Disagree, Strongly Disagree):

Q1: Course objectives were clearly stated.

Q2: Course met stated objectives.

Q3: Prerequisite courses at my high school adequately prepared me for this course.

Q4: Course content was at a college level.

Q5: Assigned text/reading materials/team assignments were appropriate to facilitate learning.

Q6: Course provided me with up-to-date information that was beyond the information presented in prior courses at my high school.

Q7: Course provided me with up-to-date information and/or contemporary examples.

Q8: Topics in this course were presented in a sequence that facilitated learning.

Q9: It was made clear to me that this was a college course.

Q10: University grading procedures were explained to the class.

Q11: Test scores were fair.

Open-ended questions:

Q12: What was the most difficult topic?

Q13: What topic received too much class time?

Q14: What topic received too little class time?

Q15: What did or did not convince you this was a college course?
